## Requirements:

- Use one additional source to find information on your person. (i.e., the internet, magazine article, book, movie, etc.)
- Create a trifold board on the life and contributions of your person. This will be on display at our wax museum.
- Prepare a 1-minute, **first person**, oral description of your selected person and why their contributions are significant.
- Memorize your 1-minute oral report. You, as the historical figure, will come to life when visitors to the museum click a button that says, "tell me more information."
- Dress up as your historical figure on the day of the Wax Museum and be prepared to "come to life and give your report."
